

Multiple Inheritance

- By providing a list of base classes, you will get multiple inheritance.
- Multiple inheritance is a generalization of single inheritance.
 - You can specify the access right for each base.
 - For classes the access right are by default `private`; for structs the access rights are by default `public`.
 - When you use multiple inheritance, your base classes should be disjunct.
 - The [adaptor pattern](#) is a typical use case of multiple inheritance.
