

# Match

- With `std::regex_match` you can decide if the text matches a character pattern.
- `std::regex_match`
  - Has an overloaded version without a match object. This version returns a boolean.

```
std::string text="C++";  
std::string regExpr(R"(C\+\+)");  
std::regex rgx(regExpr);  
  
if (std::regex_match(text, rgx)) { . . .
```
